The minimum distance separation (MDS) is a tool used in Ontario to determine a recommended distance between a livestock facility and another land use, with the objective of preventing land use conflicts and minimizing nuisance complaints from odors, and thereby reduce potential land use conflicts. This document replaces all earlier versions of the MDS Formulae and sets out MDS for new development from existing livestock facilities.
