A PSYCHOANALYTIC INVESTIGATION OF AGGRESSION AS A GAP IN THE PROCESS OF DEVELOPMENT, HOW IT BECOMES ORGANIZED INTO COMPLEXES AND SYNDROMES, AND THEIR RELATIONSHIP TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SELF

This study looks at acting out and at risk behavior as symbolic language of the self in our attempts to heal the gaps in the process of our own development. Case studies begin with an in utero experience and progress through the development of the self. They demonstrate how our earliest sensory experiences are contained within our body. When overwhelming anxiety occurs these early sensory experiences express themselves in altered bodily functioning. With continued development they become organized into complexes and syndromes, each with a dynamic core. Contained within each core is an unbearable gap in the psychophysiological process of development. These gaps are expressed in unconscious feelings of fragmenting, collapsing, losing our mind, inability to breathe, physically falling to pieces, becoming lost in space; of unconsciously feeling psychotic. This pathological separation then becomes a self-protective defense and any attempt to change is experienced as a threat to our very survival. Our instinct becomes one of resisting development itself. the case material reveals how the unbearable, unconscious anxiety is that of re-experiencing the gap, the painful feelings of psychoses. the concept of somatization as reactions to stimuli, drives, defenses and the conflict between them is well documented in the psychological and psychoanalytic literature as unsuccessful attempts to resolve underlying aggression. It appears that acting out behavior is a psychosymptomatic process. the body expresses in behavior the physiological symptom as a projection of the self. the self demands we bring the gap into consciousness. Case material demonstrates the compulsion to repeat the emotional content of complexes and syndromes over and over again as a projection of the self in our attempt to master the trauma in our body. Our behavior then becomes our symbolic language.

This is done by showing some causal connection between the hero's free will and his suffering, by bringing to the fore the interplay of the forces of destiny and human freedom. Knox states that Freud was wrong when he suggested that it was "the particular nature of the material" in *Oedipus* that makes the play so deeply moving, and not the contrast between destiny and human will. Knox believes that this play has an overpowering effect upon us, not only because we share the tendency of *Oedipus* to direct "our first sexual impulse towards our mother" and "our first murderous wish against our father," as Freud tells us, but also because the theological modification of the legend introduced by Sophocles calls into question the sacred beliefs of our time (Knox, 1982, pp. 133-137).
