He was criticised by the Victorian society on the issue of the declining status of rural people in Britain. He was basically a poet. Initially he started writing poems. But he gained fame after his novels, such as 'Far from the Madding Crowd', 'The Mayor of Casterbridge', 'Tess of the d'Urbervilles' and 'Jude the Obscure'. Two of his novels, 'Tess of the d'Urbervilles' and 'Far from the Madding Crowd', were listed in top 50 on the BBC survey- The Big Read.
